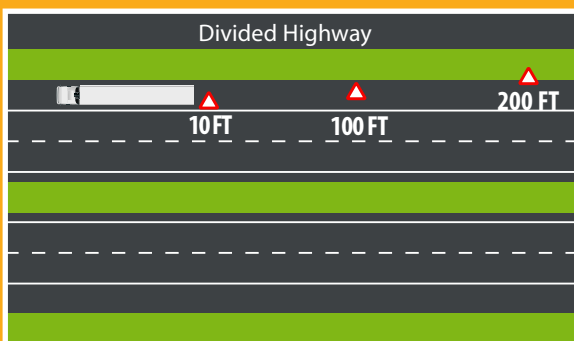
## ROADWAY SAFETY (PART 2)



### *Broke Down – Now What?*

There is not much worse that can happen at work, then to get stranded alongside the road. Unfortunately, it happens and when it does we need to be prepared. Make sure each and every day before you hit the road, all of your lights (including hazards) are working, you have a charged fire extinguisher, first aid kit, spill kit, flares/hazard triangles, hi-viz clothing, replacement fuses, etc.

- 1st.** Stay Calm/Turn on your hazard lights
- 2nd.** Try to get the vehicle to a safe location off of the roadway, otherwise pull off onto the shoulder as far as safely possible
- 3rd.** Apply the vehicles' emergency brakes
- 4th.** Stay in the vehicle and call a Supervisor/Manager
- 5th.** Put on appropriate Hi-Viz clothing
- 6th.** When safe to do so, exit out of the vehicle to put out flares/hazard triangles/LED Lighted Road Flares
- 7th.** Get back in the vehicle and wait for help to arrive.
