



## SAFETY





Emergencies can happen at any time when driving a commercial motor vehicle. Before starting your day, make sure you are prepared...

- Arrive at work fit for duty by having a good night's rest.
- ✓ Wear required personal protective equipment (PPE) for the job at hand. Don't forget high visibility clothing or vest.
- Ensure truck has a20-lb fire extinguisher and you know how to use it.
- Keep a flashlight or headlamp.
- Have at least one set of safety triangles.
- Always have a spill and first kit.
- Annual inspection and cab insurance card.
- ✓ Driver's vehicle inspection report (current / previous day).
- Medical card and driver's license.
- Always carry extra water and snacks just in case.
- Keep a charged phone for use in the event of an emergency.
- ✓ Watch weather forecast and always be vigilant when there is a chance of severe weather in the area.
- Dress for work and weather conditions.
- Call 911 in the event of an emergency.
- Reach out to your manager or supervisor if you have any questions or concerns.
