FATALITY PREVENTION



Workplace culture, organizational systems and leadership affect the risk of fatalities, and what safety professionals can do to prevent deaths.

There are three vital aspects to the prevention of accidents at work.

- Creating a safe place to work
- The development and operation of safe working practices
- Ensuring the personal safety of all employees

Below are key factors employers should consider:

- Implement a system to track and learn from close calls that could have resulted in a fatal incident
 - Use LEADING indicators instead of LAGGING indicators
- Involve employees in the safety process whenever possible
- Provide employee safety training that is specific to their job
- Observe employees working to ensure safe work practices
