KNOW YOUR SHELTER

Locate designated storm shelters at work and at home.

2



STAY WEATHER-AWARE

Enable phone alerts and monitor local forecasts. When traveling, check conditions along your route and at your destination.

3



PREPARE AN EMERGENCY KIT

Include water, flashlights, batteries and medications. Keep employee emergency contacts accessible in the workplace shelter.

4



REVIEW YOUR PLAN

Review communication and meeting plans before storm season, and update them as needed.

5



ACT ON WARNINGS

Seek shelter immediately when a tornado warning is issued.

TAKE A FEW MINUTES TODAY TO REVIEW YOUR SEVERE WEATHER PLAN.

Preparedness starts before the storm arrives.
