CHEMICAL SPILLS CAN CREATE SERIOUS RISKS FOR EMPLOYEES, THE PUBLIC, AND THE ENVIRONMENT. PROTECT YOURSELF FIRST BY SECURING THE AREA, NOTIFYING THE PROPER CONTACTS, AND FOLLOWING ESTABLISHED SPILL RESPONSE PROCEDURES.

✓ WHY IT MATTERS



Reduces the risk of injuries, exposures, fires, and environmental damage.



Protects coworkers, customers, and the surrounding community.



Helps ensure regulatory compliance and minimize operational disruptions.



TIPS & ACTIONS



STOP WORK IMMEDIATELY IF A SPILL IS DISCOVERED.



KEEP PEOPLE AWAY FROM THE AFFECTED AREA AND ESTABLISH A SAFE PERIMETER.



IDENTIFY THE MATERIAL ONLY IF IT CAN BE DONE SAFELY AND WITHOUT EXPOSURE.



NOTIFY YOUR SUPERVISOR AND FOLLOW COMPANY EMERGENCY REPORTING PROCEDURES.



USE SPILL RESPONSE EQUIPMENT AND PPE ONLY IF TRAINED AND AUTHORIZED TO DO SO.

Your first responsibility is **personal safety**; when a spill occurs, secure the area and follow the response plan.
