



SAFE WORK AREAS START WITH EACH OTHER

Safety is not only about what you do. It is also about looking out for the people working beside you. When you see a hazard or unsafe condition, speak up and follow up.



LOOK OUT FOR THE NEXT PERSON

Before leaving a work area, check for spills, debris, trip hazards or unsecured equipment. Fix it, report it or alert the right person.

SPEAK UP

You do not need to be a supervisor to say, “Let’s take care of that before someone gets hurt.” A quick conversation can prevent an injury.

FOLLOW UP

Do not assume someone else will handle it. Correct the hazard if you can do so safely. If you cannot, report it and make sure it gets addressed.

RECOGNIZE GOOD CATCHES

Acknowledge coworkers who stop an unsafe task, clean up a hazard or take an extra precaution. Recognition encourages safe behaviors.

LOOK OUT FOR EACH OTHER

Simple actions such as offering to spot someone or saying, “Hold up, that doesn’t look right,” help build a stronger, safer crew.
